The slabs are available in size 3000 x 1000 mm and 3000 x 1200 mm and in 5 mm and 3 mm thicknesses. The product is A1 class fire-resistant and does not emit toxic smoke, making it an ideal product for facades.

Kaleainterflex slabs are thin, lightweight slabs that offer ease in handling for wall cladding and facade applications. Being a porcelain material, the product is hard, highly resistant to fire, scratch, water and dust. Its smooth surface does not retain dirt making it almost completely maintenance free.
